



Guidelines for Synopsis Preparation

A synopsis is a blueprint of the dissertation that an MBA student intends to undertake. It provides a structured outline of the research problem, objectives, methodology, and expected outcomes. The following guidelines will help students in preparing an effective synopsis.

Topic- Choose a topic specific to your area of specialization

Who can be your supervisor?

- · An industry professional with 3 years of experience and a master's degree or its equivalent.
- · PhD (optional)

Synopsis must align with the following format:

Format Requirements

Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt

• Spacing: 1.5 line spacing

· Alignment: Justified

Margins: 1-inch on all sides

· Page Numbers: Bottom-right corner

Length: Typically 5-10 pages

Structure of the Synopsis

Title Page

- Title of the research (should be concise and clear)
- · Name of the student
- SAP ID
- Name of the institution/department
- Supervisor's name and designation

Introduction

- Background of the study
- Importance and relevance of the research
- · Brief discussion on the research area

Statement of the Problem

- · Clearly define the problem under investigation
- Justification for selecting the problem

Research Questions

- · They form the basis of literature review, methodology and analysis
- · They must align with the aim of the study

Objectives of the Study

- · List the specific objectives the research aims to achieve
- · Objectives should be SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, and Time-bound)

Review of Literature

- Summary of previous research related to the topic
- Identification of research gaps

Research Methodology

- Research Design: Descriptive, exploratory, experimental, etc.
- Data Collection Methods: Primary (surveys, interviews, etc.) and/or Secondary (books, journals, reports, etc.)
- · Sampling Method: Population, sample size, and sampling technique
- Tools for Data Analysis: Statistical tools, qualitative techniques, or software (e.g., SPSS, Excel, Python, R, etc.)

Scope of the Study

- · Geographical, industry-specific, or demographic limitations
- Expected contribution to academia, industry, or society

Expected Outcomes

- · What the study aims to establish
- Practical implications of the research

Limitations of the Study

Constraints related to time, data availability, sample size, etc.

Bibliography

· List of sources cited in the synopsis

Submission Guidelines

- Submit the synopsis in soft copy on LMS before the given deadline.
- Ensure proper formatting and proofreading before submission
- Seek prior approval from the supervisor before the final submission



Guidelines for Dissertation Preparation

A dissertation is a comprehensive research document that MBA students must submit as part of their degree requirements. It presents an in-depth analysis of a specific research problem and includes findings based on systematic investigation. The following guidelines will help students in preparing a well-structured dissertation.

Format Requirements

· Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt

Spacing: 1.5 line spacing

Alignment: Justified

Margins: 1-inch on all sides

Page Numbers: Bottom-right corner

Length: Typically 60-100 pages

Structure of the Dissertation

Title Page

- Title of the dissertation (should be precise and meaningful)
- · Name of the student
- · SAP ID
- Name of the institution/department

- Supervisor's name and designation
- · Submission date

Declaration and Certificate

- Declaration by the student stating originality of the work
- Approval certificate from the supervisor or institution

Acknowledgements

· Recognition of individuals and institutions that assisted in the research

Abstract

- Summary of the dissertation (approximately 300-500 words)
- · Brief outline of research problems, methodology, and key findings

Table of Contents

• List of chapters and sub-sections with page numbers

List of Figures and Tables

• Enumeration of all figures and tables used in the dissertation with respective page numbers

Introduction

- Background of the study
- Importance and relevance of the research
- Research Questions
- Objectives of the study
- Structure of the dissertation

Literature Review

- · Comprehensive review of previous research in the field
- Identification of gaps in the literature
- Theoretical framework or conceptual model

Statement of the Problem

- Research Design: Descriptive, exploratory, experimental, etc.
- Data Collection Methods: Primary (surveys, interviews, case studies) and/or Secondary (books, journals, reports, etc.)
- · Sampling Method: Population, sample size, and sampling technique
- Tools for Data Analysis: Statistical tools, qualitative techniques, or software (e.g., SPSS, Excel, Python, R, etc.)

Data Analysis and Interpretation

- · Presentation of collected data in tabular or graphical formats
- Interpretation of key findings
- · Statistical or qualitative analysis results

Discussion and Findings

- Comparison with previous studies
- Explanation of significant results
- · Contributions to theory and practice

Conclusion and Recommendations

- · Summary of findings
- Practical implications and recommendations
- Suggestions for future research

References

- · List of all sources cited in the dissertation
- · Follow a standard referencing style (APA)

Appendices

Additional data, questionnaires, interview transcripts, etc.

Submission Guidelines

- Submit the dissertation in soft copy on LMS before the given deadline.
- Ensure proper formatting and proofreading before submission
- Seeking prior approval from the supervisor before the final submission
